Typically, truck cranes have 2 different cabs. One cab is for controlling the crane and the other is for driving the truck when the unit is in transport mode. These cranes are very helpful for building locations where a crane is needed in many different locations for the duration of the build. This is due to the fact that the crane can be driven easily from one place to another. Cranes could also be transported to various construction sites on the road as they drive themselves, that eliminates the need for extra transport vehicles. Being able to travel on their own really lessens transport costs at the end of the day. The truck crane however is not stable enough to handle all the major loads which a hydraulic crane could handle. Hence, to be able to fix this issue, outriggers can be extended from the deck. The outriggers utilize hydraulic pressure to be able to lift the truck slightly off of the ground, making it stable and balanced. The crawler crane is unique in that it has huge tracks on the bottom of the crane. These huge tracks are very similar to bulldozers and backhoes. The tracks allow the crane to move around a construction site successfully.
